Wendy Dingwall ran her own travel business in South Florida for over 12 years. In 2001 she moved to the mountains of Northwest, North Carolina. Two years later she began working for a local book publisher, marketing authors and their books, and fulfilling a lifelong dream, began writing her first mystery novel, . In July 2009 she opened her own publishing company and in the spring of 2011 will have published 13 books by various notable southern authors.

Since starting in the publishing business, Dingwall created an Author's Handbook for Marketing Fiction, been a guest speaker on *Marketing Authors and their Books* at High Country Writers, was a guest on two Publishing panels at Cape Fear Crime Festival in 2006, and gave a Dialogue Workshop at the May We Write Conference in 2007.

Dingwall is a past president and strong supporter of the High Country Writers Association, that meets twice monthly in Boone, North Carolina. She has been a member since 2002, and in early 2005 she helped to form a small critique group known as the *Fellowship of the Rose*.

Hera's Revenge: An Yvonne Suarez Travel Mystery is Dingwall's debut novel. She continues to work on the second and third novels in her Yvonne Suarez Travel Mystery series.

She currently resides on a 50 acre farm near Boone, NC with her husband, Walter, their 2 Maltese dogs, 1 cat, and miscellaneous wildlife.

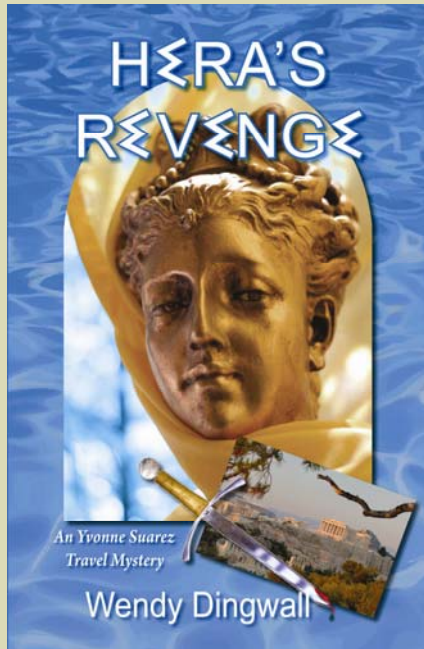

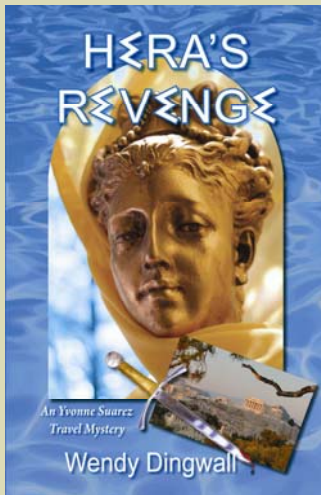

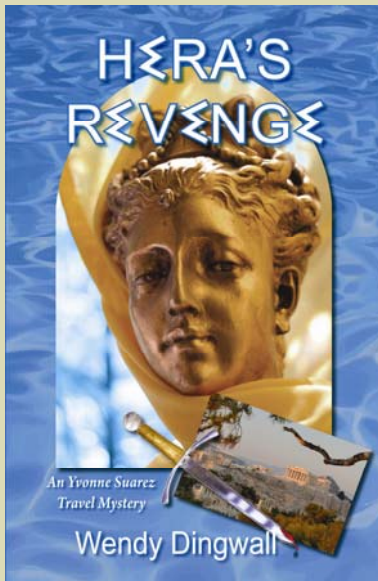
